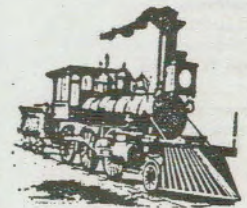
Coming Next Month

Bring your prized engines and other means of motive power for this contest. Three awards will be made in each category.



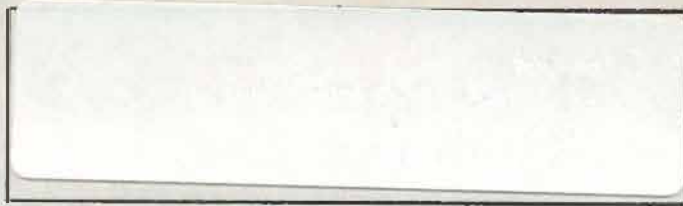
