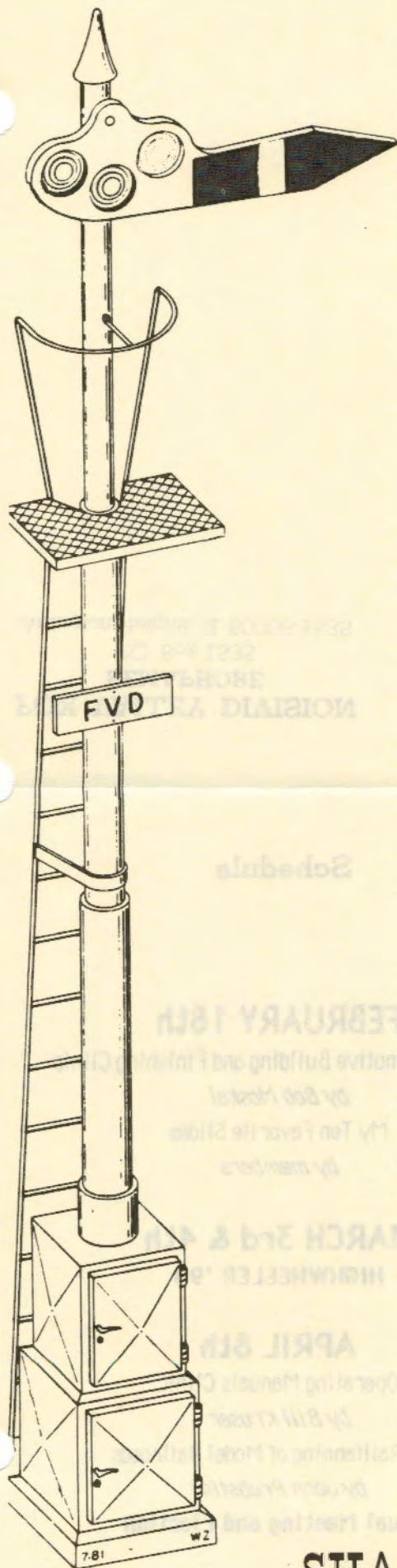

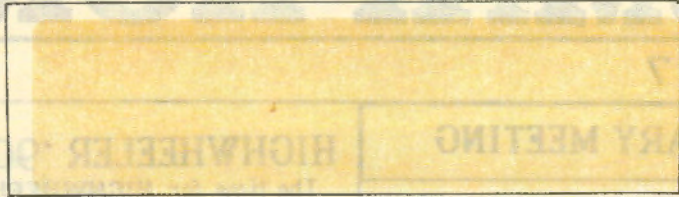


ELECTIONS

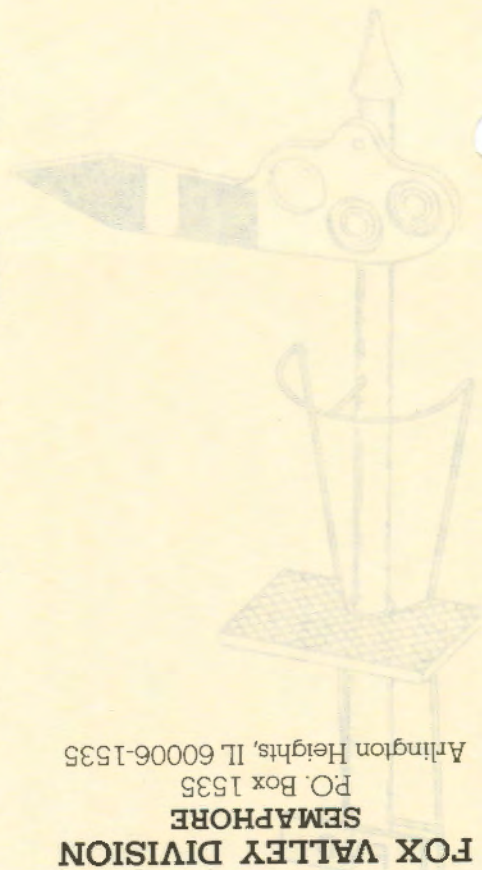
