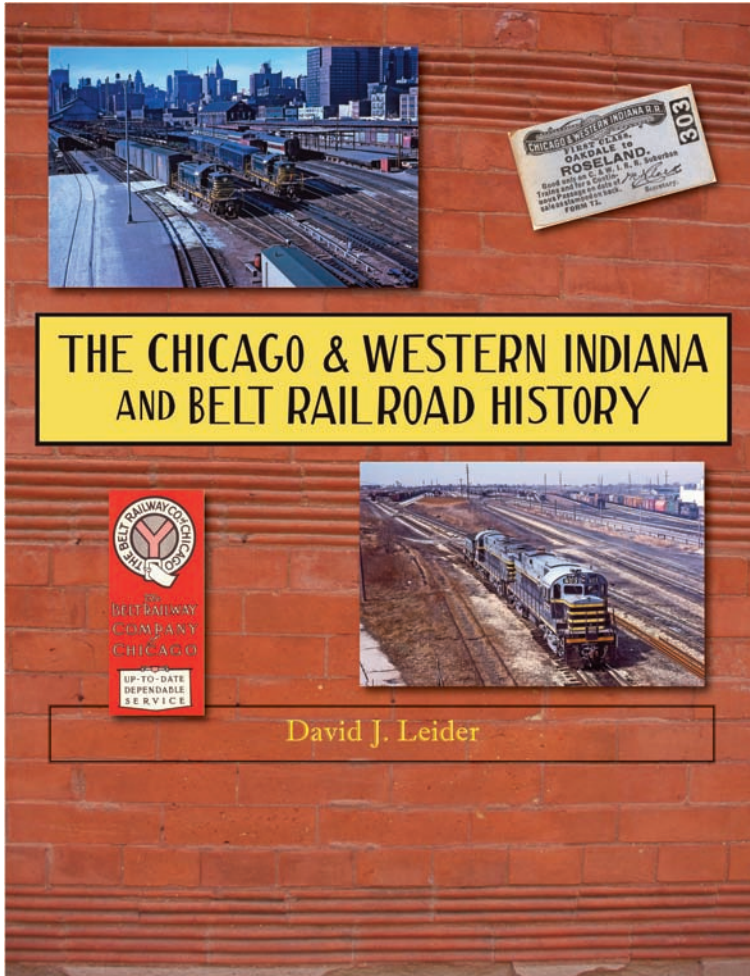


The Chicago & Western Indiana and Belt Railroad History
