Special Events in 2026

Bunny Trains: March 28 & 29, April 3 & 4

Take a ten-mile round trip train ride to The Elegant Farmer, where you can take photos with the Easter Bunny himself. An on-board scavenger hunt and displays in the Depot will make this a fun family event. On the return trip, all children will receive a gift. Boarding is only done at our East Troy Depot. Advance reservations are required.

Mother's Day – May 9 – Mom Rides Free! Mom's ticket is free with the purchase of one or more additional tickets.

Armed Forces Day – May 16 – Military & Vets Ride Free!

Night Photo Shoot – May 16 – Tickets required.

East Troy Day – May 22

Residents of the East Troy / Mukwonago area ride Free!

Father's Day – June 21 – Dad Rides Free!

Dad's ticket is free with the purchase of one or more additional tickets.

Milwaukee Day – June 27

Celebrate Milwaukee's railway history with our recently restored Chicago North Shore & Milwaukee interurban car, an historic Milwaukee streetcar, and restored Chicago North Shore & Milwaukee Merchandise Car 228.

Chicago Day – July 11

Four of our Chicago, South Shore & South Bend (CSS&SB) railroad cars turn 100 years old this year! Join us for a historic birthday party. Tickets are also available for a Chicago themed Lunch aboard two CSS&B dining Cars!

Railfan Day – August 22

Multiple trains will be running in each direction today. This will create unique opportunities for riders to see and photograph trains passing each other. A rare "behind the scenes" train ride and tour of the maintenance facility will also be available.

Beer Tasting Train – August 29

Join us for a fun and educational beer tasting train! Enjoy five different beers while traveling the route of the East Troy Electric Railroad. This event features hors d'oeuvres with every round of tasting and the train is a joint event with the Black Point Estate on Geneva Lake. Advance reservations required.

Grandparent's Day – September 13

Grandparents tickets are free with the purchase of one or more additional tickets.

Harvest Fest Trains – September 5 through October 31

We recommend that you purchase tickets in advance for all our Saturday and Sunday trains Sept. 5th through Oct. 31st. Tickets are good for all trains all day. Walk-up tickets

will be available, subject to demand, but folks who purchased tickets in advance will board first. The Elegant Farmer will be offering apple picking, hayrides, a corn maze and special food offerings in the barn cafe.

Trick or Treat Trains – October 2, 9, 16, 23, and 30

Bring your kids or grandkids in costume and we'll take a train from the Depot in East Troy to Brynes Park, where kids can go "Trick-or-Treating" and play games. After the train trip back to the East Troy Depot each kid will receive their own pumpkin. Advance purchase required.

Christmas Trains – Nov 27, 28, 29; Dec. 4, 5, 6, 11, 12, 13, 18, 19, & 20.

Our magical ride will take you from our East Troy Depot to Santa's workshop located at the Elegant Farmer. Here, children can visit Santa and take a photo with the jolly elf himself! Every child and toddler ticketholder will receive a gift upon the return to East Troy. The trolleys will be heated, and bathrooms are available in our East Troy Depot. Tickets must be purchased in advance.

Come Ride With Us!

We offer weekend train rides on the last remaining segment of a once vast electric interurban railroad system that stretched for 200 miles from Milwaukee to cities across Southeastern Wisconsin. The whole railroad, including our historic cars, is a living history museum. Our Depot is a State Historical Site, and was the original East Troy Substation for the Milwaukee Electric Railway & Light Company – now known as *We Energies*.

The museum has more than 30 trolleys, streetcars, interurban cars and other equipment, including 19 that currently operate on the line. We continue working to restore our remaining cars to operating condition.

The railroad line we travel is just over 6 miles long and connects East Troy with Mukwonago. The railroad arrived in East Troy in 1907 – and trains have run here ever since!
