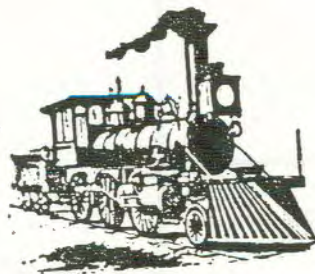
## CLINICS

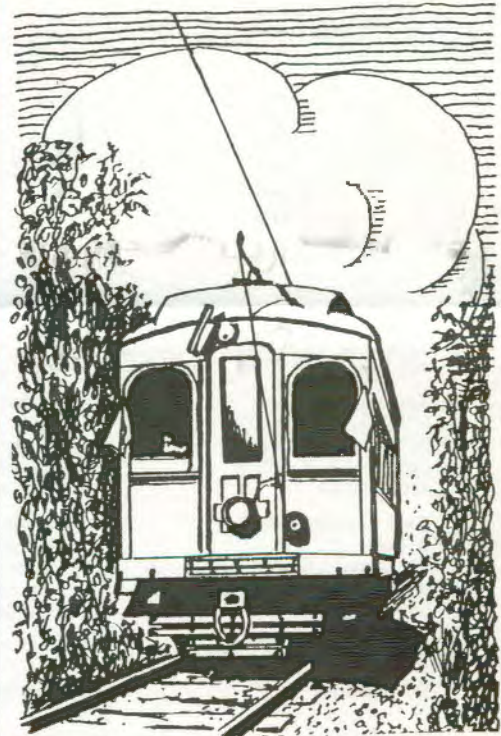


## CONTEST

Let's see a lot of entries for this contest.

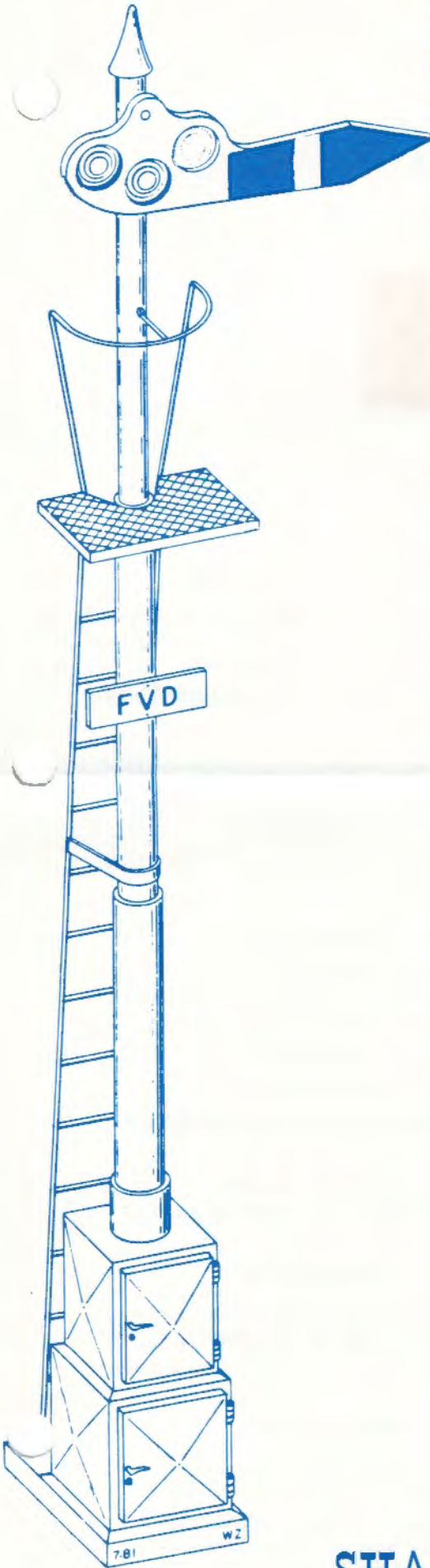


## HIGHWHEELER '89
