TOUR TO ILLINOIS LIVE STEAMERS

This will be the final meeting of this modeling year and as you can see from the above we will not be meeting at the church, but rather going on a car trip to Lockport to visit the Illinois Live Steamers and have our end-of-the-year-bash.

As always your wives or a guest are welcome to join us. It would be appreciated if you would telephone the program trainmaster Norm Smith at (708) 255-4503 to let him know that you plan to attend if you have not already done so.

The Illinois Live Steamers have requested, for safety reasons, that children not be included in the group.

We will meet at the CNW parking lot at the Arlington Race Track at the corner of Wilke and Northwest Highway at **11:30 a.m.** We will then give out maps and directions. If possible, you should try to car-pool and the cars can be left at the parking lot without any problems.

Tentatively, we should arrive in Lockport at 1:00 p.m. You will have 3 hours to roam the 7-1/2 acre grounds of the Illinois Live Steamers. During that time you will have the opportunity to see their steam and diesel locomotives operate. You will see 3-1/2" gauge (3/4" scale), 4-1/2" gauge (1" scale), and 7-1/2" gauge (1-1/2" scale) layouts. Possibly we can even get a ride on one of their locos.

At 4:00 p.m. we plan to start our end-of-the-year-bash. We will have both liquid and solid refreshments.

We will probably leave Lockport at 5:00 p.m. and should arrive back at Arlington Park by 6:00 p.m.

To those of you who have not attended the monthly meetings I invite you to join us next year. We have some very interesting and informative presentations.

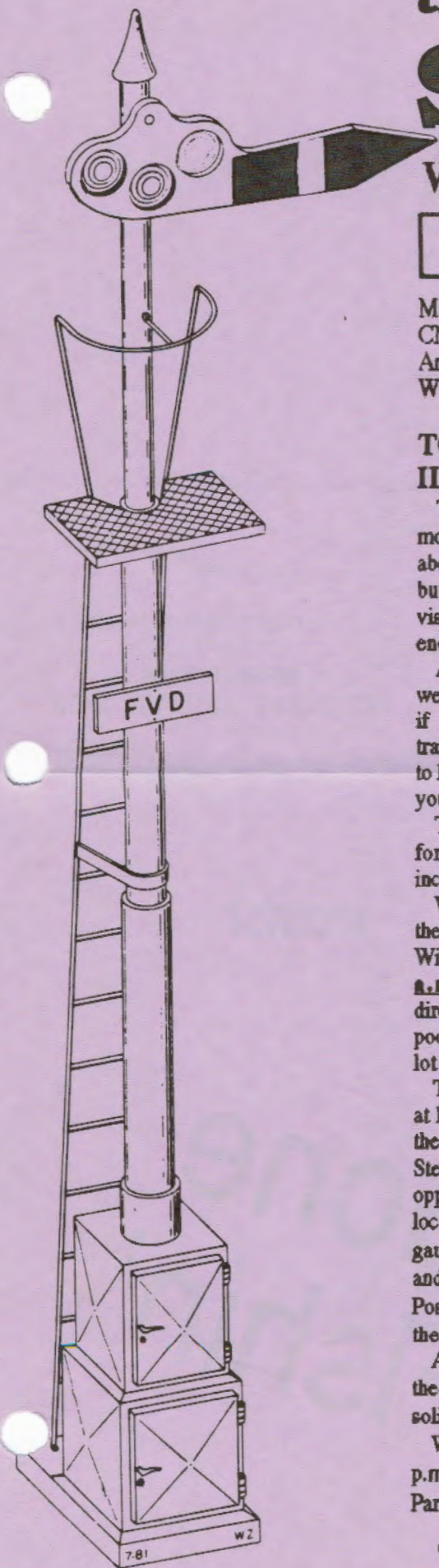
Welcome to the newly elected Trainmasters, I am sure you will find your assignments rewarding.
