Superintendent's Report

It is January and we are at the midpoint of our 2007-2008 season. That means spring is just around the corner. With the coming of spring, it is time to think about the Midwest Region Spring convention. This year the convention will be held in Waupaca, Wisconsin on May 9 - 11. If you look on a map, Waupaca is 196 miles from Prospect Heights with a driving time of 3 hrs. Not that far away.

Like all of the region conventions this one will have operating sessions on Friday night, clinics on Friday night and Saturday morning, a tour of the Waupaca Foundry Friday afternoon (I heard this is something worth seeing), layout tours Saturday and Sunday afternoon and the banquet on Saturday night. The hotel has an indoor water park, so bring your swim suits.
